## Mystery Shawl Knit-Along

### Clue 1

#### Notes:

- The edge stitches are always knit-stitches on RS and WS (unless otherwise stated), the first stitch is slipped purl wise, yarn in front, without knitting. **The edge stitches on Chart 1.**
- Ⓜ can be a 3, 5, or 7 Nupp, a Bead or a Knit Stitch just be consistent within each Clue.
- All even rows are purled except double YO-s, where first YO is purl stitch and the second YO knit stitch.
- Rows 11, 13, 15, 17: work pattern between black lines 5 times, then knit pattern on the left side
- Rows 19, 21, 23, 25: work extra sts before the main pattern, then work pattern between black lines, then work st(s) on the left side.
- After completing 30th row you should have **71 sts on your needles** (3 st edge + 65 st + 3 st edge)
- If you use stitch markers to separate each repeat be aware that some stitches may float to either side especially YO's at beginning or end of a repeat.
