

INSTRUCTION PAGE ONLY – DO NOT PRINT THIS PAGE

Hang tags **MUST** be printed on **GREEN** card stock.

This is a double-sided hanging tag, make sure that your **PRINTER** can print on **BOTH** sides of the paper.

Tag can be filled in on the computer or by hand.

When using the computer to fill in the tags please note that the **IMAGES** on the tag on page 2 correspond with the **IMAGES** on the tags on pages 3.

REMEMBER: Add a short story about your eco-friendly item. Put your story in the “My Eco-Friendly Story” section of your tag.

NOTE: If using a PDF software like Adobe Acrobat or Reader to print the green tags, then **PRIOR** to printing:

- Set the “Print” setting to “Print on both sides of paper”,
- Select the print on “Flip on short edge” button
 - Select “Landscape” orientation
- Verify that “Page Sizing & Handling” is set to “Actual Size”

1. **PRINT** double-sided pages 2 and 3 only.

2. **CUT** along the dotted lines, these are cut guidelines

3. Once tag is cut-out then **FOLD** it in half with the DFA logo appearing on the outside.

4. With the DFA logo facing you **PUNCH** a hole in the top left-hand corner of the tag by the DFA logo.

5. Use this hole to **STRING** your printed/cut tag to your green item.
